OVERVIEW

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Purpose: The End-of-First Semester Survey was designed to assess first-time, first-year student's perceptions, self-reported learning, experiences, and reasons for choosing not to re-enroll at IUPUI. The survey examined many different aspects of students' life and academic experiences and provides insights into their first semester of college at IUPUI.

Methods: Institutional Research and Decision Support administered the survey December 2019 to all first-time beginning students enrolled at IUPUI. A total of 788 students responded with a response rate of 20.9%. Amazon gift cards valued at \$100 were used as an IRB approved research incentive.

- Participants approximate the demographic characteristics of the 2019 Beginner Cohort students at IUPUI as a whole.
- Female students were more likely to respond to the survey, making up 65% of respondents.
- Half of respondents were University College students.

Executive Summary

Sense of Belonging/Organizational Commitment

- 84% of respondents agreed that the IUPUI campus community has made them feel welcome.
- 82% of respondents agreed that they feel a sense of belonging to IUPUI.

Self-Efficacy and Growth Mindset/Support

- Respondents rated themselves highest in their ability to work with others that are different from them, 98% rated themselves at least average compared to the average person.
- Students rated themselves lowest compared to others on emotional health, study skills, and self-confidence (related to social activities).
- 94% of respondents agreed they can improve their academic ability if they work hard enough.
- 91% of respondents agree there are instructors at IUPUI who care about their learning.

Satisfaction of Services/Experiences at IUPUI

- 82% of respondents were satisfied with their overall academic experience at IUPUI.
- Students were least satisfied with the following: quality of food services/options, availability of on-campus housing, their on-campus job and quality of on-campus housing.

High Impact Practices

- Slightly less than half of the respondents have already participated in community service or volunteer work (40.6%) and about one-third have participated in a learning community or some other formal program where groups of students take two or more classes together (37.3%).

IUPUI Profiles of Learning for Undergraduate Success (PLUS)

- Respondents were most confident that they can effectively work with people from different backgrounds (e.g., races, ethnicities, religions, socioeconomic backgrounds, cultural, or sexual orientations).
- Students are least confident in their ability to write a well-organized final report/paper and prepare a formal oral presentation to communicate ideas and information.

Hours Spent on Activities

- 27% of respondents reported working off-campus more than 15 hours a week during their first semester.
 - 6% of respondents reported working on-campus more than 15 hours a week during their first semester.

Plans for Next Semester

- 92% of respondents planned to re-enroll at IUPUI next semester.
- The top five reasons respondents indicated why they planned not to return to IUPUI next semester were as follows: personal emotional/mental health reasons, don't feel like they belong at IUPUI, lack of sense of community, lack of campus life and activities, and lack of friends.

Most/Least Valuable Aspects of IUPUI Experience

- The top themes that emerged when students were asked to report the most valuable aspects of their IUPUI experience were the friends they made, their professors/instructors, and the support/resources they get on campus.
- The top themes that emerged when students were asked to report the least valuable aspects of their IUPUI experience was the campus food, not making friends/having no campus social life, and parking/commuting.

Where Students Plan to Transfer

- Of the respondents that indicated they intend to transfer, most plan to transfer to Indiana University-Bloomington.

Comparisons Between Underrepresented and Not Underrepresented Groups

- Lack of campus life and activities was the number one reason for not returning given by underrepresented students while personal emotional/mental health reasons was the number one reason for not underrepresented students.

Sense of Belonging

- 84% of respondents agree the IUPUI campus community has made them feel welcome.
- 82% of respondents agree they feel a sense of belonging to IUPUI.
- 76% of respondents agree they have formed close friendships with **other students attending IUPUI.**
 - 75% of respondents agree they have formed close friendships with **other students in my academic major or school**

- Nearly half of the respondents have already participated in community service or volunteer work (40.7%) and about one-third have already participated in a learning community or some other formal program where groups of students take two or more classes together (37.3%).
- 80% of respondents plan to do a practicum, internship, field experience, co-op experience, or clinical assignment before graduating from IUPUI.

- Respondents felt most confident they can effectively work with people from different backgrounds (e.g., races, ethnicities, religions, socioeconomic backgrounds, cultural, or sexual orientations) with 85% of respondents reported feeling confident in this PLUS.
- Only slightly more than half (60%) of respondents were confident they can effectively prepare a formal oral presentation or communicate ideas and information, which is the lowest rated of the PLUS.

- 82% of respondents reported they spent zero hours during their first year working for pay on-campus.

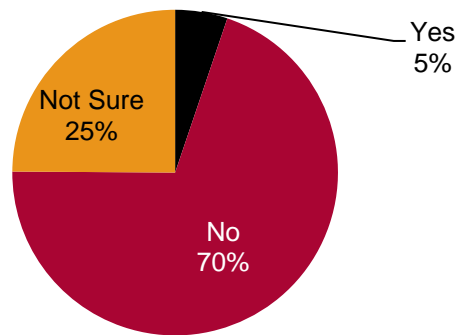


Plans for Next Semester

Intent to Transfer

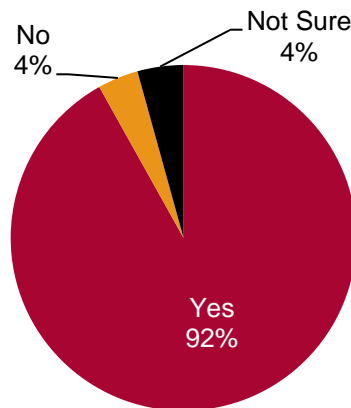
I intend to transfer to another institution?

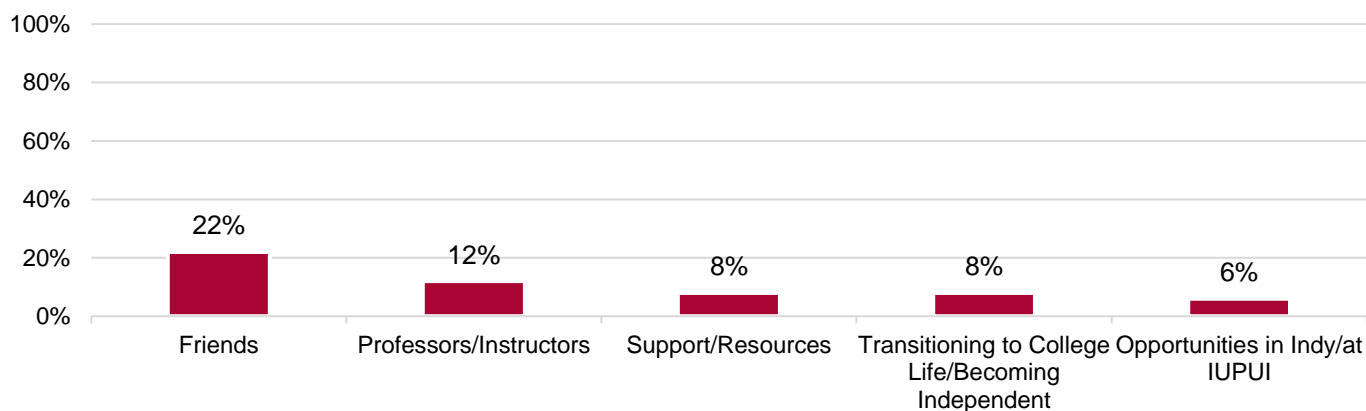

- I have a sense of independence but know I can find help if I need it.

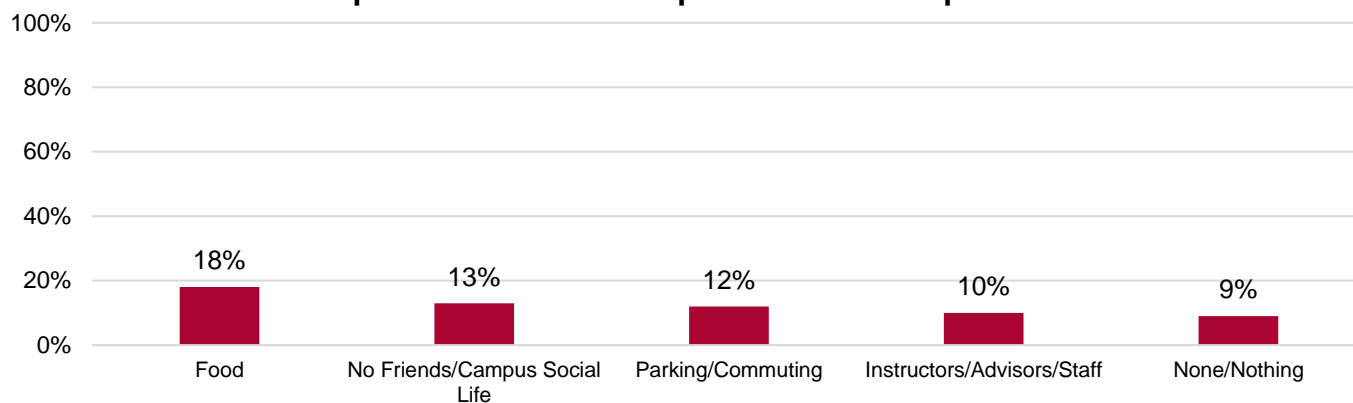
Opportunities in Indianapolis/at IUPUI (40 comments)

Food (97 comments)

- There's no decent food on campus or in walking distance.
- The least valuable aspect of IUPUI so far is the dining hall in University Tower. I have seen that the quality of the food is not as good as they say it is.
- The tower dining. I'm paying a decent amount of money to eat food that isn't always completely cooked, or it's over cooked. There's a lot of health concerns such as maggots in the food and chunky spoiled liquids.
- The meal plan has been the least valuable aspect because I have classes on the other side of campus around lunch time, so I can't use it. I also don't like how early it closes on the weekends.
- The food/inconsistency of Tower Dining. Sometimes the food is really good, and other times the food is extremely lack-luster.

No friends/Campus Social Life (71 comments)

- I have not found a group of people or a club that I feel a sense of belonging with thus far.
- Lack of social life. Everyone is either in their room or have social friends from high school. No social life exists. I honestly feel IUPUI doesn't live up to its promises
- It's not a very outgoing community, I feel very out of place here in terms of having friends.
- The social life and campus community are nonexistent. There is not much to do and is very hard to feel like I'm supposed to be here if I do not live on campus.
- The lack of activities on the weekends for anything. Most people go home but I do not have that option since I am from out of state.

Parking/Commuting (64 comments)

- The least valuable aspect here at IUPUI is parking. The parking at IUPUI is always full and there is not a lot of lots.

Instructors/Advisors/Staff (55 comments)

- The least valuable experience thus far has been working with instructors that were unprepared or did not seem to pay much attention to the individuality of us as students.
- The least valuable aspect of IUPUI thus far has been how some of my professors decide to lecture in which they will literally read off of the Powerpoint Slides that they have shared with us and not even attempt to engage us through asking of questions or some sort of participation in the class. For them, simply showing up to the class is "participation" which has a point total which I do not agree with at all. Participation should mean more than showing up to the class because there needs to be more interconnectivity.
- Some of the staff seem very uncaring at times.
- My academic advisor did not adequately prepare me for the Honors College requirements and expectations.

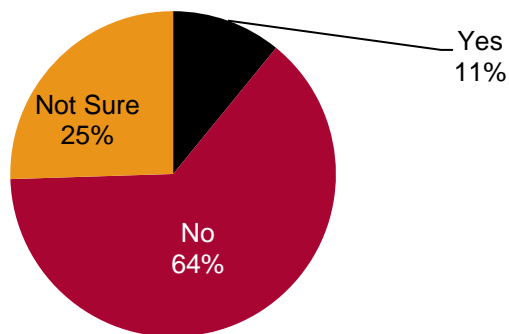

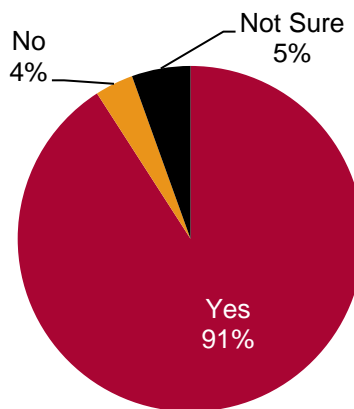

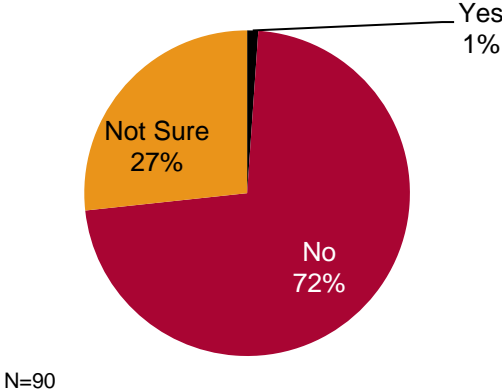

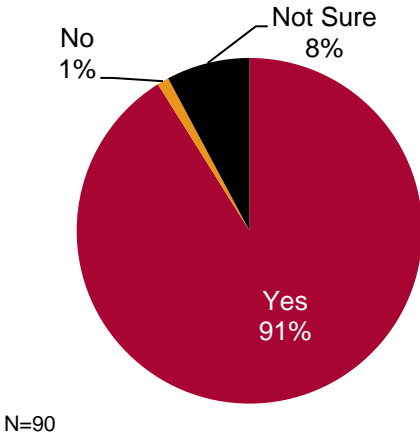
