Footnote 1 about Full-time Tuition: Undergraduates who enroll in 12-18 academic units per semester are considered full-time, and they are charged a full-time "banded" tuition rate.

Footnote 2 about Books and Supplies: Beginning with 2024-25, estimated books and required course material costs use the estimate from the College Board Trends in College Pricing and Student Aid Report (<https://research.collegeboard.org/trends/college-pricing>) along with a calculation that indexes this to the average number of credits taken in the fall and spring by full-time, degree-seeking undergraduates in the prior year. In contrast, Books and Supplies figures for prior years came from a student survey conducted by the National Association of College Stores (NACS).

Footnote 3 about Transportation Costs: Includes modest commuting costs between the campus and the student's primary residence. The figures are based on the "College Board Living Expense Budget, Low 9-Month Budget" amount for the Midwest region <https://professionals.collegeboard.org/higher-ed/financial-aid/living-expense/9-month>, using 17% for the proportion representing transportation expenses.

Footnote 4 about possible rounding errors: The costs of Tuition and Mandatory Fees are each rounded to the nearest dollar amount before being aggregated and reported above. This methodology is done to replicate how IPEDS collects and publishes this information. As such, reported amounts for Tuition and Mandatory Fees, as well as Total Estimated Costs, may vary slightly from the true costs.
