



This report summarizes the data submitted to IPEDS with the Graduation Rates Survey. The cohort is defined by the new logic introduced in retention reports which flags full-time, beginner, degree-seeking students who matriculated in either of the preceding summer sessions or in the fall of 1994, or students who began their coursework in high school and enrolled as traditional college students in the fall.

The campus specific "Institutional Graduation Rates Summary" sheets attached subdivide this cohort by degree-seeking status at time of entry (baccalaureate or other degree) and provide figures on the number and percentage of students receiving degrees within 150% of program length. The graduation rates illustrated on these sheets (A - E) represent the various ways that numbers can be used for comparison with other types of programs and institutions. The final graduation rate (E) aggregates all these subsets together into a figure that comports to previous rates and is used for external reporting.

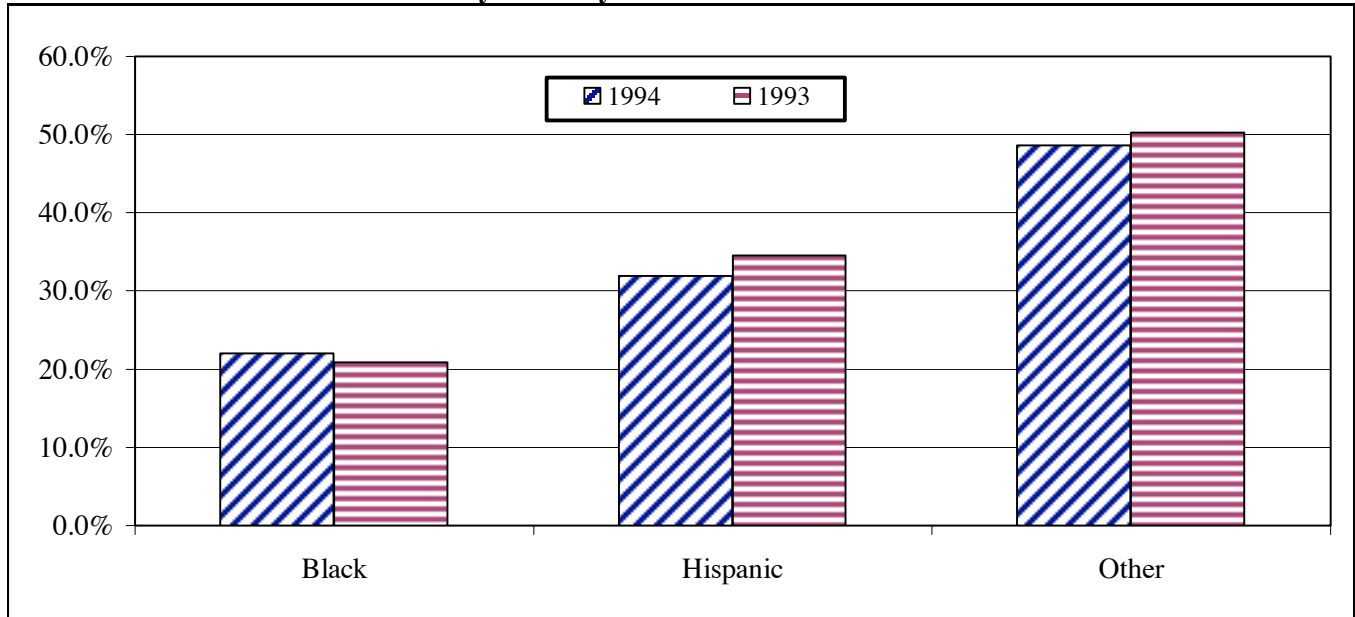

The table below depicts graduation rates by degrees received at the "home" campus and degrees received elsewhere within IU. By crediting the home campus with degrees received after intercampus transfers and completions, graduation rates are lifted five percentage points on average.
