First to Second Semester Retention: A Comparison of the Fall 86 - Fall 95 Cohorts Vol. 5, No. 2

This report focuses attention on persistence to the second semester and is meant to accompany the fall retention report (V. 5, No. 1) which depicts persistence to the second year. Retention through five semesters is provided below and with the campus profiles to illustrate the most critical period for attrition.

The Retention Tracking System (RTS) provides the source data. The RTS establishes student cohorts based upon their entry semester and tracks their academic careers through receipt of a degree. Retention is defined as re-enrollment or receipt of degree. Fall cohorts contain students who enter college for the first time in the fall or those students who start during the second summer session and re-enroll in the fall. The base campus is determined by the first fall enrollment and that campus is credited with those students throughout their academic careers regardless of intercampus transfers.


Aggregating all campuses, 82.7% of the fall 1995 cohort returned to the second semester. This figure is a .6 percentage point decrease in first to second semester persistence when compared to the fall 1994 cohort.



The graph below illustrates the relationship of course load on persistence to the second semester. Although full-time students comprise three-quarters or more of the most recent cohorts, the loss of degree-seeking part-time students rivals the full-time student loss in real numbers. This year, in particular, witnessed a decline of more than 3 percentage points in part-time student retention over the previous cohort.
