Persistence to the Second Semester Vol. 11, No. 2

This report provides views on persistence to the second semester for the incoming full-time, beginner cohorts of 1999, 2000, and 2001. Consistent with our cohort logic, students are defined to a cohort based upon their entry semester/status (fall or either previous summer session/degree-seeking beginner or transfer) and/or by their high school graduation date when appropriate. New to this report, the age categories have been adjusted to more closely approximate age ranges found in other external reports.

An appendix (11.2.1) is available which provides views on the entire beginner cohorts and part-time beginner cohort subsets. This and other reports are available via our website at http://www.indiana.edu/~rrlilly.

As part of accepted practice in retention reporting, deceased students are now excluded from the cohort figures. To protect student privacy, cells with a "began" number of ten or less are masked.

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
