I am pleased to provide you with the latest edition of the Official Retention Report. This report, like its fall predecessors, provides a view on what proportion of student cohorts return to the subsequent fall term. The precedent for the Retention Tracking System and this report grew out of the desire to generate standard and official retention figures for all campuses for self-study and reporting purposes.

As a reminder, a cohort is comprised of those degree-seeking students, beginners or transfers, who are new to an IU campus in the fall or those who began in the previous summer session and re-enrolled in the fall. This cohort definition conforms to the standards required by various external groups for reporting purposes. A student's "home campus" is defined by their first semester enrollment regardless of intercampus transfer. Retention is defined as re-enrollment or receipt of a degree.


Previous editions of this report provided data on each of the cohorts. With this and future reports, the earliest cohorts will be aggregated to provide a manageable view of the data.
