Persistence to the Second Year Vol. 12, No. 1

This report provides views on the 1999, 2000, and 2001 incoming student cohorts' persistence to the second year. The format of this report focuses on beginners who were full-time in their first fall semester. Past reports provided breakdowns on various characteristics for the entire incoming cohort (beginners and transfers combined). With this report, both below and on the first table on the campus pages, the persistence rates of beginners, transfers, and the overall cohort are displayed followed by a table that pertains to only the full-time beginners (FTB) population. This change in format responds to the guidelines for external publications (USNWR, College Board, Peterson's) to report on the FTB group exclusively.

The logic for defining incoming student cohorts is consistent across the years represented. The cohort definition recognizes the increasing population of students who began taking college courses in high school and also responds to changes implemented for federal reporting. Students included in the cohort began their academic careers as "true" college students in the fall or either of the preceding summer sessions. Additionally, deceased students are eliminated from the beginning cohort figures.

Several new variables have been added to the report. The proportion of the incoming overall and beginner cohorts represented by the FTB subset is portrayed by percentages. This figure speaks to the composition of the cohorts at IUPUI and the regional campuses and has been proposed as a new data element collected by IPEDS. Four levels of persistence by high school rank is provided as well as figures for the top five reported high schools. The raw cohort figures contained on these pages can become small when disaggregated by different variables. To protect student privacy, cells with a "began" number of ten or less are masked.

Comments and suggestions are welcomed.

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


