Persistence to the Second Year Vol. 14, No. 1

This report provides views on the 2001, 2002, and 2003 incoming student cohorts' persistence to the second year. The format of this report focuses on beginners who were full-time in their first fall semester. Reports for all beginners, and part-time beginners are available at our website.

The logic for defining incoming student cohorts is consistent across the years represented. The cohort definition recognizes the increasing population of students who began taking college courses in high school and also responds to changes implemented for federal reporting. Students included in the cohort began their academic careers as "true" college students in the fall or either of the preceding summer sessions.

This report indicates exclusions to the student cohorts (i.e. death, military service) that will be added to the standard report view. Managing and accomodating these exclusions will provide a more accurate view of persistence but may also change previously published figures.

To protect student privacy, cells with a "began" number of ten or less are masked.

Comments and suggestions are welcomed.




