IU

- Overall enrollment (not including ACP/HS) is basically stable at 93,578 (-666, -0.7%). Overall credit hours are at 1,189,827.5 (-6,202, -0.5%).
- Degree-seeking enrollment is at 90,754 (-761, -0.8%). Credit hours are at 1,176,043.5 (-5,930.5, -0.5%).
- The incoming beginner enrollment is at 16,162 (+253, +1.6%), setting a record for the third year in a row.
- Degree-seeking, domestic minority students hit a record at 22,068 (+1,212, +5.8%) now reflecting a record share of 26.7%. Within this group, other records were set for Hispanic/Latino at 7,461 (+801, +12.0%) and Asian American at 4,705 (+301, +6.8%). Bloomington, IUPUI, East, and South Bend set new records for degree-seeking domestic minority students, and all campuses except Northwest set an enrollment record for at least one single race category.
- Degree-seeking, International students declined to 7,327 (-483, -6.2%). Enrollment has been decreasing since Fall 2016 (-1,302, -15.1%).

Bloomington

- Overall enrollment is at 43,260 (-243, -0.6%) with credit hours at 579,977.5 (-743.5, -0.1%).
- Degree-seeking enrollment is at 42,760 (-177, -0.4%). Credit hours are at 576,811 (-398.5, -0.1%).
- For the third year in a row beginner enrollment set a record at 8,291 (+194, +2.4%).
- Degree-seeking, domestic minority students hit a record at 9,330 (+582, +6.7%) now reflecting a record share of 25.0%. Within this group, other records were set for Hispanic/Latino at 2,958 (+371, +14.3%) and Asian American at 2,667 (+150, +6.0%).
- Degree-seeking, International students declined to 5,271 (-351, -6.2%). Enrollment has been decreasing since Fall 2016 (-1,088, -17.1%).

IUPUI

- Overall enrollment is at 29,537 (-42, -0.1%), marking the fifth straight year of decreasing enrollment. Overall credit hours declined to 371,631.5 (-570, -0.2%). While Fort Wayne's enrollment (+313, +72.1%) has grown since last year, both Indianapolis (-314, -1.1%) and Columbus (-41, -2.8%) figures are down.
- Degree-seeking enrollment is at 28,598 (-112, -0.4%). Credit hours are at 366,955 (-424.5, -0.1%).
- New enrollment and credit hour records have been set for degree-seeking, full-time students at 22,523 (+261, +1.2%) and 328,879 (+1,865, +0.6%). New records also apply to both the undergraduate and graduate levels for full-time enrollments.
- Doctoral-research (+68, +8.5%) and doctoral-practice students (+45, +1.6%) are at record levels.
- Degree-seeking, domestic minority students hit a record at 7,910 (+483, +6.5%) now reflecting a record share of 29.6%. Within this group, other records set include Hispanic/Latino at 2,395 (+286, +13.6%) and Asian American at 1,684 (+116, +7.4%).
- Degree-seeking, International students declined to 1,736 (-120, -6.5%).

East

- Overall enrollment set a new record at 3,766 (+44, +1.2%). Overall credit hours also set a new record at 38,812 (+464, +1.2%).
- Degree-seeking enrollment is at 3,271 (+75, +2.3%). Credit hours are at 36,852 (+694, +1.9%).
- Degree-seeking, full-time students set new records for enrollment at 2,060 (+79, +4.0%) and credit hours at 29,066 (+615, +2.2%). These increases have been driven, in part, by the records set for degree-seeking, full-time undergraduates at 2,021 (+54, +2.7%) and 28,684 (+383, +1.4%).

- Degree-seeking, full-time graduate enrollment and credit hours have grown appreciably to 39 (+25, +178.6%) and 382 (+232, +154.7%).
- Degree-seeking, domestic minority students hit a record at 479 (+66, +16.0%) now reflecting a record share of 16.1%. Within this group, other records set include Hispanic/Latino at 137 (+19, +16.1%), African American at 173 (+4, +2.4%), and Asian American at 38 (+11, +40.7%).

Kokomo

- Overall enrollment set a new record at 3,164 (+41, +1.3%). Overall credit hours also set a new record at 38,633 (+404, +1.1%). Both continuing their largely positive trends over the last decade.
- Degree-seeking enrollment is at 2,910 (+12, +0.4%). Credit hours are at 37,760 (+297, +0.8%).
- Degree-seeking, undergraduate credit hours set a record at 36,648 (+367, +1.0%).
- Degree-seeking, full-time undergraduates set new records for enrollment at 2,314 (+56, +2.5%) and credit hours at 33,366 (+511, +1.6%).
- Degree-seeking, domestic minority enrollment is at 421 (-3, -0.7%), three students shy of the record set last year. Within this group, records set include Hispanic/Latino at 187 (+32, +20.6%) and Asian American at 30 (+1, +3.4%).
- Degree-seeking, International students set a record at 61 (+8, +15.1%).

Northwest

- Overall enrollment is at 3,877 (-82, -2.1%). Overall credit hours are at 44,481.5 (-803.5, -1.8%). Both mark the ninth straight year of decreases.
- Degree-seeking enrollment is at 3,633 (-114, -3.0%). Credit hours are at 43,360.5 (-847.5, -1.9%).
- Degree-seeking, undergraduate beginners increased for the third straight year, and is now at 686 (+12, +1.8%).
- Degree-seeking, domestic minority enrollment increased to 1,716 (+14, +0.8%), following the downward trend that began in 2012.
- Degree-seeking, female student enrollment is at 2,623 (-8, -0.3%) and has set a new record by constituting more than 72.2% of the student body.

South Bend

- Overall enrollment is at 5,092 (-122, -2.3%). Overall credit hours are at 60,593.5 (-1,937, -3.1%). Both are at their lowest levels in the past decade and continue downward trends that began in 2011.
- Degree-seeking enrollment is at 4,910 (-172, -3.4%). Credit hours are at 59,593.5 (-2,201, -3.6%).
- Degree-seeking, domestic minority students hit a record at 1,404 (+76, +5.7%) now reflecting a record share of 29.8%. Within this group, other records set include Hispanic/Latino at 673 (+95, +16.4%) and Asian American at 92 (+9, +10.8%).
- Degree-seeking, International students decreased to 158 (-17, -9.7%).

Southeast

- Overall enrollment is at 4,882 (-262, -5.1%). Overall credit hours are at 55,698.5 (-3,016, -5.1%). Both are at their lowest levels in the past decade and continue downward trends that began in 2012.
- Degree-seeking enrollment is at 4,672 (-273, -5.5%). Credit hours are at 54,711.5 (-3,050, -5.3%).
- Degree-seeking, domestic minority enrollment is at 808 (-6, -0.7%) now reflecting a record share of 17.5%, despite being six students shy of the record set last year. Within this group, Hispanic/Latino set a record at 232 (+6, +2.7%).



Online

- IU Online now comprises 135 degree and certificate programs from IU's 7 campuses.
- The percent of students enrolled in at least one distance education course grew to 34.4% (up from 32.5%).
- Students taking all distance education courses remained steady at 8,768 (up from 8,760), representing 9.4% of IU's enrollment (up from 9.3%).
- The number of students enrolled in online programs grew 10.2% to 6,335.
- Credit hours from online courses represent 13.1% of all credit hours at IU, up from 12.4%.
- At the IU regional campuses, online courses represent 28% of all credit hours, up from 26.2%.
- IU East remains the campus with the largest online presence, with 44% of its students enrolled in online programs and 79% of its students enrolled in at least one online course.
- IUPUI remains the largest enrollment in online classes with 12,209 students in at least one online course while IU Bloomington remains the largest enroller of students in online programs (2,750).

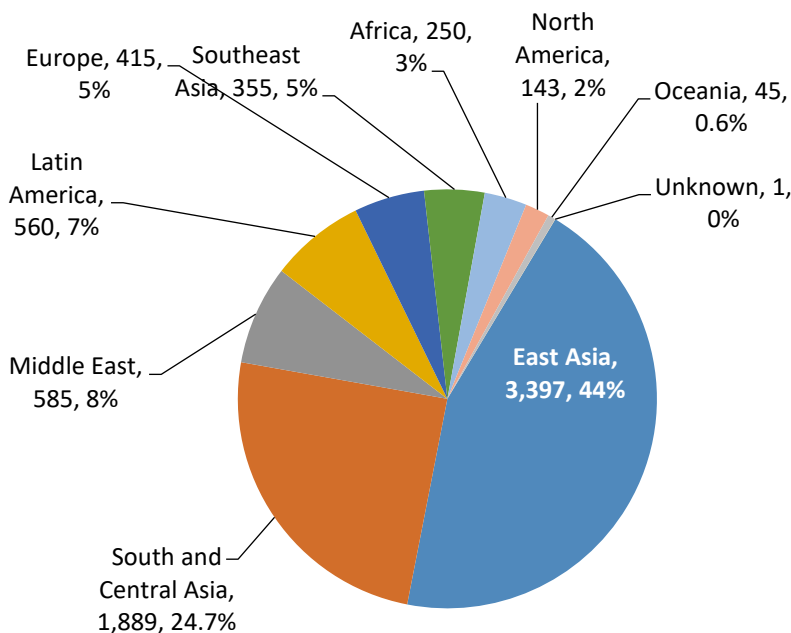
