Spring 2017 Enrollment Summary

Indiana University

- Total enrollment for IU decreased -1.8% to 101,823 (includes IPFW) while the credit hour figures increased to 1,193,779.0 (0.4%) over last spring.
- Degree-seeking head counts fell to 91,171 or -1.3%. Credit hours for this group are at 1,152,542.5 or an increase of 1.6%.
- Hispanic, Asian American, and two or more races counts were at record levels this spring. Similarly, international students also set a record.

Bloomington

- Total enrollment is 44,358, which is a decrease of -0.4% (188) over last spring. Credit hours are 552,392.5, which is an increase of 0.3% (1,819.5) over last spring and a new record level.
- Degree-seeking undergraduate headcount and hours were both records. Headcount increased 0.2% (57) to 31,303. Hours increased 0.6% (2,868) to 456,731.
- Graduate level (masters and doctoral), degree seeking headcounts grew by 240 (2.5%) and hours increased slightly by 527 (0.6%).
- Junior and senior enrollment grew by 218 (2.9%), 279 (2.7%), respectively. While freshman enrollments decreased by 356 (-6.5%) and sophomore enrollments decreased by 84 (-1.0%).
- Hispanic/Latino enrollment set a record of 2,109 (146; 7.4%), Asian American set a record of 2,073 (126; 6.5%) and Two or More Races was also a record of 1,392 (70; 5.3%). African American enrollment increased (73; 4.4%), only 3 students off the record set in 2010 record.
- International enrollment increased to a record 5,912 (111; 1.9%).

IUPUI

- Total enrollment is 28,061, which is a decrease of -0.9% (261). Credit hours are 352,081, which is an increase of 2.9% (9,880) over last spring and a new record level.
- Undergraduate enrollment decreased by 165 (-0.8%), but hours set a record, increasing 2.8% (6,933) to 258,458. Average hours per undergraduate student increased 3.6%, from 12.8 to 13.2.
- Graduate enrollment was a record at 88,910, up 3,977 (4.7%).
- Freshman level enrollments decreased by 168 (-4.5%), sophomores decreased 44(-1.0%), while junior and senior enrollments both increased slightly by 17 (0.4%) and 30 (0.4%), respectively.
- Non-resident enrollment set a record of 3,454 (7.4%).
- Hispanic/Latino (148; 9.6%), Asian American (84; 6.7%) and Two or More Races (51; 5.4%) enrollment increased and set records, while African American enrollment decreased by 63 (-2.5%) and white decreased by 407 (-2.2%).
- International enrollment set a record of 1,938, up 50 (2.6%).

East

- East had an overall decrease in heads and hours. Total enrollment is 4,004, which is a decrease of -3.2% (131) over last spring. Credit hours are 36,070.0, which is a decrease of -2.3% (831.0) over last spring.
- Undergraduate, degree-seeking enrollment decreased by 142 (-4.8%) and hours decreased by 988.0 (-3.0%), with decreases in each class: freshman, sophomore, junior and senior. However, average hours per undergraduate student increased from 10.9 to 11.1.
- East set a records at the graduate level for both headcount and hours. Enrolment increased by 33 (23.1%) and hours increased by 119 (14.9%).
- Resident enrollment decreased by 120 (-5.9%), and reciprocity enrollment dropped by 29 (-8.4%)

Kokomo

- Kokomo set a record for total hours. Total enrollment increased to 3,462 (1.2%) and credit hours increased to 34,988.0 (2.7%).
- Undergraduate enrollment decreased by 20 (-0.8%) but hours set a record of 31,281, up 2.2% (669). Average hours per undergraduate student increased 3.0% from 12.2 to 12.6.
- Graduate enrollment increased by 19 (17.8%) and hours increased by 202 (26.6%).
- Freshman level enrollment fell by 80 (-12.7%), sophomores fell by 36 (-5.7%), while junior and senior levels increased by 38 (6.8%), 58 (8.5%). Junior enrollment set a record at 599.

Northwest

- Total Northwest enrollment and credit hours decreased to 4,692 (-3.7%) and 47,132.0 (-4.8%), respectively.
- Undergraduate enrollment fell by 355 (-9.5%) and hours decreased by 3,038 (-6.9%), while average undergraduate hours per student increased 2.9% from 11.7 to 12.1.
- Enrollment at all undergraduate degree-seeking levels fell: freshman (116; -13.1%); sophomore (142; -15.4%); junior (43; -5.5%) and senior (54; -4.8%).
- African American enrollment declined by 78 (-10.8%).

South Bend

- South Bend overall enrollment decreased to 6,024 (-5.9%) and credit hours fell to 62,294.0 (-0.8%), respectively.
- Undergraduate headcount decreased by 218 (-4.7%) but hours increased by 160.0 (0.3%), resulting in a 5.2% increase in average hours per undergraduate student, up from 11.8 to 12.4.
- Freshman, sophomore and senior enrollment fell by 72 (-6.6%), 110 (-9.8%) and 58 (-3.9%), respectively.
- Hispanic enrollment set a record at 457, up by 15 (3.4%).
- International enrollment decreased by 50 (-22.9%).

Southeast

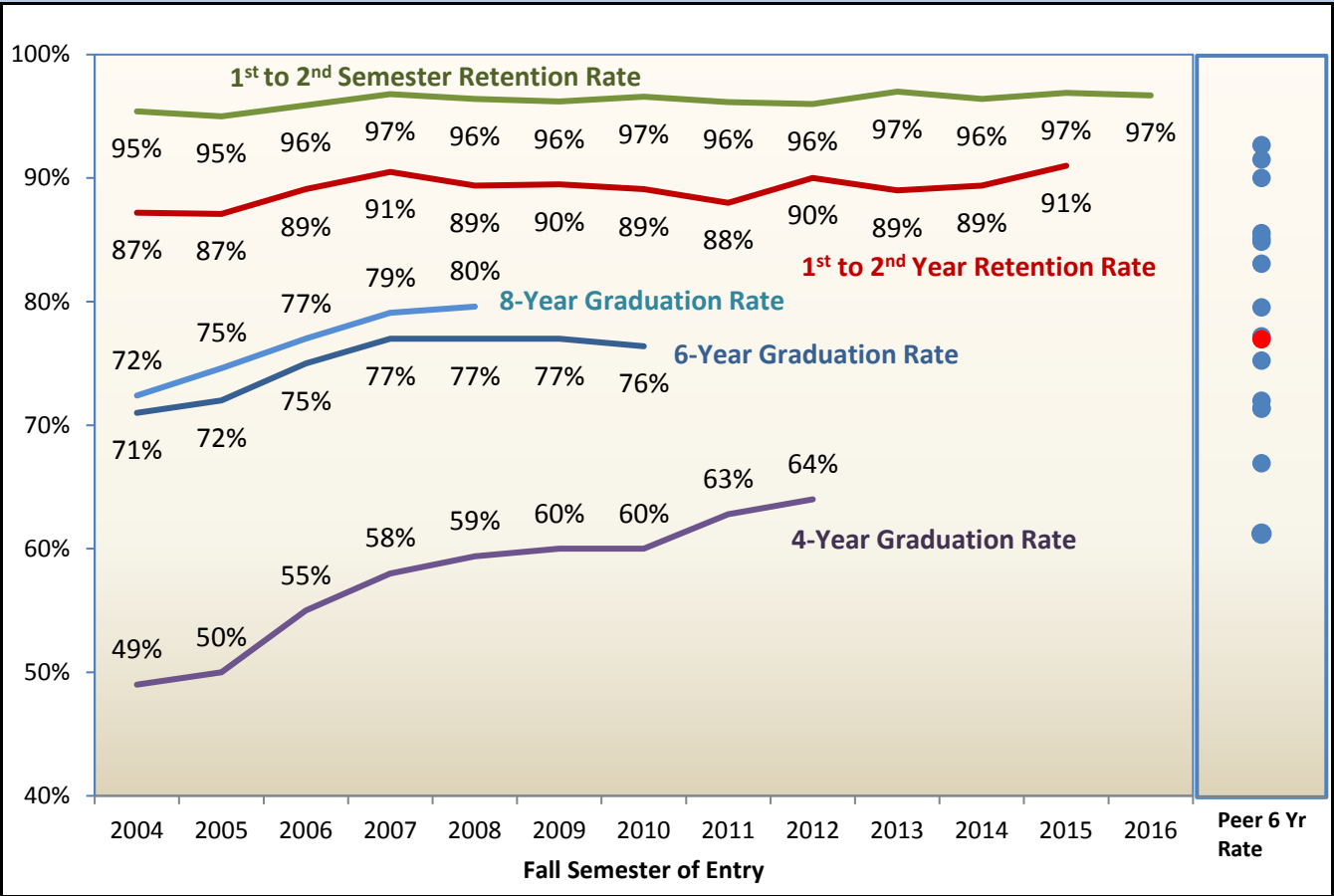
- Total enrollment and credit hours decreased to 5,234 (-6.8%) and 55,821.5 (-4.2%), respectively.
- Undergraduate enrollment fell by 402 (-8.3%) and hours decreased by 2,611 (-4.8%). But there was a 3.8% increase in average hours per undergraduate student, up from 11.3 to 11.7.
- Enrollment at all undergraduate degree-seeking levels fell: freshman (122; -11.9%); sophomore (123; -10.7%); junior (78; -6.6%) and senior (79; -5.3%).
- Male enrollments fell by 221 (-10.5%), female decreased by 213 (-6.9%)
- Resident enrollment fell by 212 (-6.1%), non-resident enrollments declined by 222(-12.7%) and reciprocity enrollments declined by 223 (-13.2%).
- African American enrollment decreased by 23 (-6.9%).
- International enrollment increased by 7 (36.8%).

Fort Wayne (IU students only)

- Total enrollment and credit hours decreased to 5,988 (-6.2%) and 52,999.0 (-3.2%), respectively.
- Undergraduate enrollment fell by 194 (-4.9%) and hours decreased by 1,378.0 (-3.0%).
- Undergraduate counts fell for freshman (102; -7.1%), junior (31; -4.8%) and senior (80; -6.9%). Sophomore levels were up 19 and 2.7%.

Note: The grand totals for each campus includes both degree-seeking and non-degree-seeking – first “bullet” only. All other subtotals (level, gender, residency, etc.) are degree-seeking only.

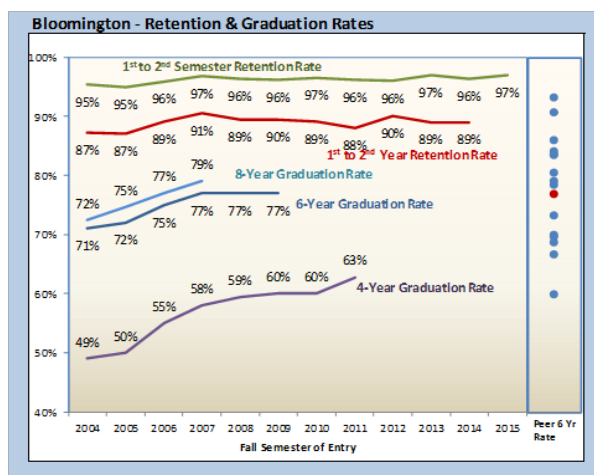
Understanding the Campus Panels

Various stakeholders and external groups require colleges and universities to calculate and supply data on retention and graduation rates. As a very public measure of our success at educating and credentialing students, these metrics provide a valued method of comparing institutions. Unfortunately, these measures rely on a cohort model of tracking; including only those incoming beginner students who were taking a full-time course load in the fall of the first semester. Regardless of what happens beyond the first semester, e.g. becoming part-time, these same students are “tracked” and reported on for years to come. For a residential campus like Bloomington this model is fairly representative. However, IUPUI and the regional campuses – because of the dynamic student populations they serve – do not compare well to residential campuses. Emerging models of reporting are attempting to provide a “fuller” picture of success for these students including the Student Achievement Measure (SAM) provided in these panels.

At IU we provide an inclusive view of activity within the university. The outcome of a student who starts at Kokomo but re-enrolls and/or receives a degree at IUPUI will be credited to the “home” campus of Kokomo. Historically, between 2 and 5% of our retention and graduation rates can be attributed to intercampus mobility.

Retention is typically measured by how many students return for a second year of education. This is defined as re-enrollment in the subsequent fall or completion of a degree. Because students may not make a two semester commitment to their education, retention to the second semester is a valid, intermediate measure of persistence. The first panel in this report compares these various measures for FT beginner cohorts since 2004.

Graduation rates begin with the same cohort of incoming beginners who were full-time but the “numerator” becomes the receipt of a degree. The rates in this panel reflect *only* students who intended to earn bachelor’s degrees and were successful in gaining that credential in four, six, or eight years. Additionally, the right hand side of the chart shows where the IU campus graduation rates fall among their peers.

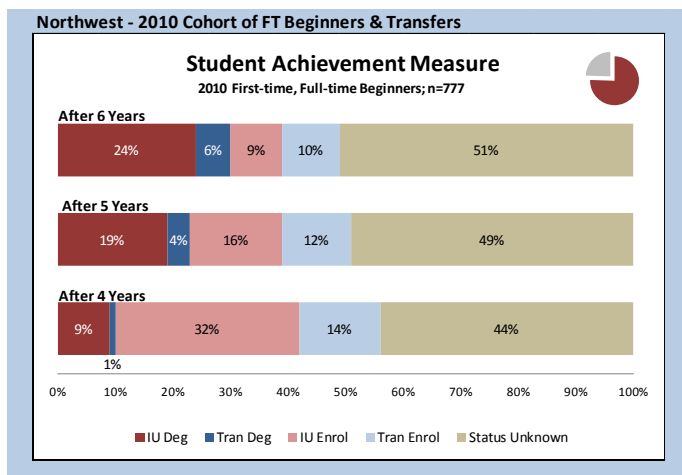

The second panel illustrates the standard six-year graduation rates for the 2010 cohort of FT beginners by a variety of student characteristics. These rates reflect bachelor’s degrees earned within six years. The “Financial Aid Status” reflects proxy measures for low income (Pell) and middle income (Subsidized Loan, no Pell) students.

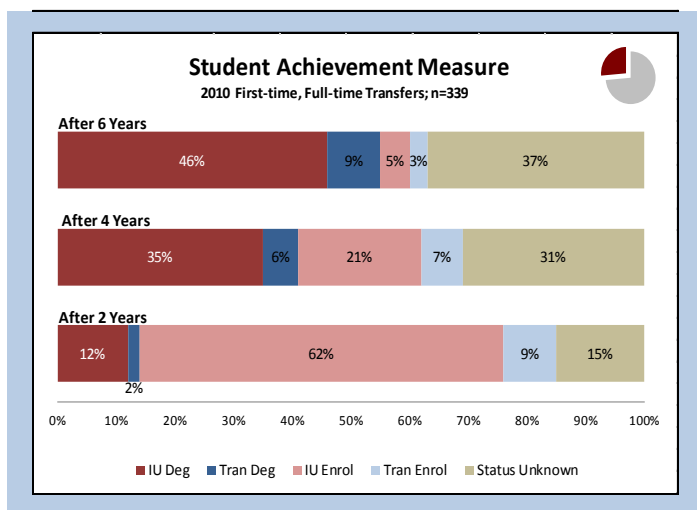
Student Achievement Measures (SAM)

The standard graduation rates measure reports on the success of *beginning* students only, rendering a certain proportion of the outcomes as “unknown”. We recognize that many of these “unknowns” are actually students who transfer to continue their education at another institution. Another major shortcoming of this approach is that it excludes those students who come to us as transfer students. Recently, multiple higher education associations (i.e. AAU, APLU, AACC, ACE, AASCU, NAICU) espoused a new, more inclusive metric on completions addressing both of these shortcomings. The Student Achievement Measure or SAM, provides a measure of both beginner and transfer students, and includes activity outside the home institution.

SAM takes full-time beginners in the fall cohort (bachelor’s or associate seeking) and reports on the receipt of any degree or subsequent enrollments in years four, five, and six. Unlike the IPEDS graduation rates, SAM credits the institution with degrees earned both inside and outside of 150% of program length (i.e. 3 years for associates or six years for bachelor’s degrees). The pie chart symbol in the upper right hand corner illustrates the proportion of the overall incoming cohort is beginner.



The next panel is the SAM metric for incoming student transfers who were full-time in the fall of 2010.



It is important to note that there are no adjustments made to this cohort based upon the number of hours these students transfer into IU. For example, a student with 65 hours is starting at the same point as a student bringing 20 hours into IU. Hence, the outcomes at years two, four, and six for the transfer cohorts should be expected to be higher than native beginner students because of this “head start.” With the state’s emphasis on facilitating the transfer of students among the two and four year institutions, this metric will be even more important going forward.
