- 12. This will initiate the download of a zipped folder. Unzip the downloaded folder to open the CSV document.
- 13. The CSV file contains a list of institutions and their peers. Column B is the selecting institution, while Column E is a list of the selecting institution's peers. For instance, if you filtered column B by 'Indiana University Bloomington', you will see a list of all IUBLA's peers in Column E. Conversely, filtering column E by 'Indiana University Bloomington' will reveal a list of institutions in column B which selected IUBLA as a peer.
