If the total library expenditures = 0, the institution will not submit the Academic Libraries component. If annual total library expenditures are > 0, the institution will submit Section I of the Academic Libraries component. Institutions with total library expenditures >\$100,000 will report additional expenditures and interlibrary services information in Section II of the Academic Libraries component.
